

OUR STUDIO/CLASSROOM IS AVAILABLE FOR RENTAL!

Rental fees for use of the Pottery Studio space are \$25 per hour with a two-hour minimum. This is not for member-conducted classes that are open to the public. It includes event time, set-up, and breakdown. Reasonable cleanup is expected. Tables and chairs are a per available. A PCAC member must be present.

OPEN STUDIO HOURS:

Open studio is for intermediate and advanced students only. It is not to be used for production pottery. Participants must have taken at least two ceramics classes at PCAC or be able to demonstrate comparable ceramics experience.

Participants have access to the ceramics studio during PCAC's regular business hours for up to 8 hours per week, except on days when regularly scheduled events are meeting there. There is no instructor present. A calendar of events will be available. Failure to follow studio rules, including complete and timely clean-up, will result in open studio privileges being revoked.

Amenities include: wheels, tools, glazes, a small storage shelf, and firing. Kiln is fired to Cone 04. Participants must purchase their own low-fire clay through GLCAC for \$8 per 12.5 pound bag.

Participants will be required to sign an open studio contract. This includes a safety waiver and a list of studio rules.

Fee: \$75 per month, payable in advance, with additional fee for clay.

HAND-BUILDING CERAMICS CLASS

Hand Building classes will be 6 sessions; one session each week for 6 weeks. Classes to be announced. No experience is necessary, but all skill levels are welcome. Concentration in this class will be using hand-building techniques!

Enrollment in this class provides access to PCAC's kiln and ceramic glazes. Enrolled students may also work on their own during open studio hours, at no additional charge. Open studio hours will be posted each month.

Group size is limited to eight, to allow for individual instruction time. Early registration is encouraged. Experienced potters are welcome to join this class to experiment and learn new techniques. Student work is fired on-site to Cone 04. Due to the nature of the ceramic process, some completed works will be available during the 6-week class period and the rest available within two weeks after the close of the class.

Fee: \$120.00 (5 pounds of clay included; 12.5 additional pounds of clay available for \$8.00)

WORKSHOPS FOR SCOUT TROOPS/ 4-H CLUBS/OTHER YOUTH GROUPS REQUIRING ART PROJECTS

Designed for students wishing to meet requirements for art badges or fair entries, etc. Your reservation includes an instructor, supplies and private use of the classroom space for two hours. Group size is limited to 10 students for ceramics; 12 students for drawing and painting. Open dates may be limited.

Drawing: \$15/Participant (minimum of 6 students)

Painting: \$15/Participant (minimum of 6 students)

Ceramics: \$22/Participant (minimum of 6 students)

YOUTH BIRTHDAY PARTIES

Birthday parties may be scheduled for children ages seven and up. Your reservation includes an instructor, supplies, private use of the classroom for two hours, and 30 minutes lead time to decorate. Paper plates, paper cups and napkins are provided, should you wish to bring refreshments. Group size is limited to 10, and at least one supervisory adult in addition to the instructor is required.

Art project to be arranged at time of reservation.

ADULT BYOB WORKSHOPS

Bring your own beverages and complete a project with friends. Your reservation includes an instructor, supplies, and private use of the classroom for three hours. Paper plates, paper cups and napkins are provided, should you wish to bring refreshments. Group size is limited to 15. Participants must be at least 21 years of age.

Acrylic Painting: \$25/Participant plus the cost of materials

Ceramics: \$30/Participant

QUICK-START WHEEL THROWING – BY APPOINTMENT

Quick start wheel throwing is a one or two session private lesson (possibly 2 students at a time) in which you are given a private lesson on centering and shaping on the wheel. Most of the time would be spent in guided practice. Sessions would be 3 hours long: one session as described and a follow up lesson to learn trimming.

Fee: \$120 (\$60.00 per session) contingent upon availability of an instructor.

K-12 SCHOOL GROUPS- BY APPOINTMENT

Our art center is proud to serve the community! School and private groups: guided gallery tours are available free of charge, by appointment. Upon request at the time of scheduling, a simple art activity can be designed to fit curriculum needs at a charge of \$2.00 per student. Minimum group size is 15; maximum group size is 30.

SPECIALTY WORKSHOPS:

From time to time, special one day make-and-take (or make and pick up later) workshops will be offered. Individual teachers may propose these classes/workshops at least 30 days prior to their offering date. Suggested fees will be comparable to Painting (\$25/participant) and Ceramic (\$30/participant. These will need to be proposed to the pottery/classroom manager and the master calendar manager.
